2. You MUST have paid your \$35 for Astrocamp before we leave on Friday May 6 at 4pm. Food is included in the cost. You also must fill out the medical form and allergies form before we leave.
3. The sleeping arrangements are in dormitories, in bunk style beds with mattresses.
4. White light ruins your night vision, and it ruins imaging telescopes. You will not be allowed to use lights with white light after dark. (You will make a lot of Astronomers very upset!)
5. You must cover your torch with red cellophane
6. There may not be mobile reception, and there will not be internet or 3G reception
